others as you would like to be treated. Wouldn't it be great if everyone would seek to treat others in the same manner that they themselves would like to be treated? You see, when asking yourself what I should do today, one thing that should come to mind is, I should do to others, just as I would have them do to me. (Ref. Matthew 7:12; Luke 6:31) 4. You should hold fast to what is good and do good. When considering what to do today, make holding fast to what is good, and seeking to do good a priority. You see, brethren, as children of God we should always abhor what is evil, and cling to what is good, always remembering that our God is well pleased with us when we do good. (Ref. Romans 12:9, 21; Galatians 6:9-10; 1 Thessalonians 5:21-22; Hebrews 13:16) 5. You should look out for the interest of others. Sadly, we live in a society today that is very self-centered. Too many today possess a selfish attitude, and they make everything all about themselves, and they often never consider the interest of others. However, when thinking about what you should do today, consider looking out not only for your own interest, but also for the interest of others. (Ref. 1 Corinthians 10:24; Philippians 2:3-4) 6. You should seek to live peaceably with all men. When asking what I should do today, be ever mindful of the need to pursue peace with all men. Brethren, never forget, as the people of God, we need to daily make it our aim to do whatever we can on our part to live peaceably with all men. (Ref. Romans 12:18; Hebrews

12:14) 7. You should search and meditate upon the Scriptures. When you ask yourself what should I do today? Know that you can, and should, open your Bible to search and meditate upon the Scriptures. You see, we all should search the Scriptures daily, and we should study to show ourselves approved unto God. So, when you are debating upon what you should do today, remember to rejoice always in the Lord. (Ref. Philippians 4:4; 1 Thessalonians 5:16) 10. You should do whatever you do to the glory of God. Brethren, no matter what you choose to do today, when you consider what you should do today, just remember to do whatever you do to the glory of God! You see, as a child of God you must remember to always strive to let your light so shine before others, and you must never forget, whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. (Ref. Matthew 5:14-16; 1 Corinthians 10:31) So, when asking yourself, "what should I do today?" May you consider doing the things mentioned above.
