- They carouse in their deceptions. (2 Peter 2:12-15)
- They speak words of emptiness. (2 Peter 2:18)

- They are out to entice and draw away disciples after themselves. (Acts 20:30)
- They use flattery words, and are out to deceive the hearts of the simple. (Romans 16:18)
- They overthrow the faith of some. (2 Timothy 2:18)
- They will lead those who follow them down the pathway of destruction. (2 Peter 2:1-2)

How Are We To Deal With Wolves In Sheep's Clothing?

- We are to note and avoid them. (Romans 16:17)
- We are not to fellowship with them who are of the unfruitful works of darkness. (Ephesians 5:11)
- We must expose them. (Ephesians 5:11)
- We must silence them. (Titus 1:10-11)
- We must not receive them. (2 John 9-11)
