

Godliness

- "Godliness" is "the quality of being godly" and it denotes one who shows love and reverence for God by living in obedience to Him.
- A soul-winner must be one who exercises themself towards godliness. (1 Timothy 4:7-9)

Love

- "Love" can be defined as "an intense feeling of deep affection" and it denotes a great interest and pleasure in someone or something.
- A soul-winner must sincerely show and manifest love. (Mark 12:30-31; Ephesians 4:15, 5:2)

Compassion

- "Compassion" literally means "to suffer with" and it is a quality that moves one into action.
- A soul-winner must be one who is compassionate like Jesus. (Mark 1:41; Luke 7:13)

Knowledge

- "Knowledge" is "understanding gained through study and learning" and it denotes knowing something with familiarity.
- A soul-winner must have a knowledge of God's will. (Ephesians 5:17; 2 Timothy 2:15)

Shows No Partiality

- "Partiality" is "the quality of being partial" and it denotes to show favor unfairly or one who is bias.
- A soul-winner must be one who shows absolutely no partiality. (Romans 2:11; Ephesians 5:1; James 2:9)

<u>Gentleness</u>

- "Gentleness" is "the quality of being kind, tender, mild-mannered" and it denotes a mildness of one's manners or disposition.
- A soul-winner must be one who is gentle, and shows gentleness. (Galatians 6:1; 2 Timothy 2:24)

Patience

- "Patience" is "the quality to endure difficult circumstances" and it denotes the ability to continue to do something despite the difficulties without complaining or becoming annoyed.
- A soul-winner must be patient. (2 Timothy 2:24, 4:2)

Humility

- "Humility" is "the quality of being humble" and it denotes having a modest or low view of one's own importance.
- A soul-winner must be humble. (2 Timothy 2:24-25)

Diligence

- "Diligence" is "a constant and earnest effort to accomplish what is undertaken" and it denotes the quality of a hard-worker.
- A soul-winner must be diligent, and abound in the work of the Lord. (Romans 2:11; 1 Corinthians 15:58)

<u>Persistence</u>

- "Persistence" is "the quality of continuing in a course of action in spite of difficulty or opposition" and it simply denotes not giving up.
- A soul-winner must always be persistent in prayer, in seeking to win souls for the Lord, and never give up. (Romans 10:1; Colossians 4:2-3; 1 Corinthians 3:6; Galatians 6:9-10)

God's Plan of Salvation

- Hear the word of God. (Romans 10:17)
- Believe in Jesus Christ the Son of God. (Acts 8:37)
- Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)
- Confess Jesus Christ. (Romans 10:9-10)
- Be baptized into Christ for the remission of your sins. (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; Galatians 3:27-29)
- Remain faithful unto death. (Revelation 2:10)
